

Enable New Zealand Low Rise Lift Process

The Occupational Therapist advises which lift is suitable for the client's injury related needs. They get a quote and send it to book a builder with BGIS, who manage this on behalf of Enable New Zealand.

The Occupational Therapist sends Enable the lift order.



BGIS contractor liaise with the lift supplier regarding specifications to build platform and necessary build works for the lift install.



Enable New Zealand equipment team issues the Purchase Order to the lift installer.



BGIS contractor will let the installer know when the property is ready for lift install.



The lift installer will then come and install the selected lift at a time organised.



Installation of the lift is then signed off by the clients, Occupational Therapist and BGIS contractor.



BGIS can complete and sign off any other building work before the lift is installed.

This is because the lift install is not part of BGIS scope of work.
