Considerations when Ordering Equipment



Clinical requirements

- Professional scope of practice
 - Discipline-specific
 - Appropriate training and experience
- Take a broad focus of client's needs

ACC Assessment Contract requirements

- Service scope
- Type of referral



Considerations when Ordering Equipment

ACC MRES requirements

- MRES Operational Guidelines

ACC principles

- Stay within scope
- Injury-related need
- Cost effectiveness
- Recycle and reuse equipment
- Share your thinking
- Equipment use





Consider Trial and Purchase...before Hire

Purchase

Simple or Standard List item

Trial/Purchase

Complex List or Non-list item



Hire

Equipment is:

- Required for less than 2 months
- Of high dollar value >\$3000
- Unable to be reissued
- Not available on ACC List, or in reissue
- Needed immediately



Documentation Requirements for Equipment Orders

Complex Equipment

All require:

Assessment report

Some require:

Trial quote –
 check list
 entry

Non-list Equipment


All require:

- Assessment report
- Trial quote

Complex & Non-list **Wheelchairs**

All require:

- Assessment report
- Trial quote
- Wheelchair specification form



Provide **clinical justification for all equipment features** quoted, especially for those additional to what is included in the base cost.



Recall Date

Recall date

Select an estimated recall date for the time you expect the person's covered injury to recover

Estimated Recall Date




When your person has a lifelong need, set a date 20 years from your order date. To do this, type in this format (e.g.) 21 May 2044. If the client isn't ready to return the equipment by the recall date, this can easily be extended.



Key Messages

- Contact the Clinical Services Advisors for advice about equipment solutions
- Check out our resources
- Consider ACC list items first when selecting equipment, then non-list and hire as the last resort
- Consider your scope of practice and responsibilities as an assessor
- Include the correct documentation to complete your equipment order
- Add a recall date to your order
